What does the procedure involve?

A surgical Neck Lift procedure involves creating an incision behind the ear, slightly into the ear, or a small incision under the chin. The skin is separated from the fat and the muscle below and the underlying fat is either trimmed or liposuctioned to obtain an improved, more sharply defined neck contour. If necessary, the platysma (muscle in the neck) will be tightened to treat the bands in the central neck. Incisions are placed so that the scars are minimal and hidden, and these scars will fade in time to become scarcely visible. This technique creates a more youthful, natural looking, and contoured neck.


What can I expect following the procedure?

- Recovery time varies and will depend on your individual healing rate.
